DOEACC Society follows a mandate to carry out HR Development and related activities in the field of Information, Electronics and Communication Technology. Amongst various other courses, that, the Society is currently offering, the Society has supplemented its basket of IT Literacy course with its new training programme on computer basics namely Basic Computer Course (BCC).

In today's changing world computer literacy has become an essential skill and this course is designed to impart computer skills at the very basic level. The eligibility criterion for applying and appearing in the BCC examination is VIII Standard i.e any individual who has passed Class VIII may apply for the BCC Examination. The total duration of the course is 36 hours, and the examination fee is Rupees Two Hundred plus service tax, as applicable only.

Apart from other benefits, that, the aspirants are likely to gain by undergoing this course, it would be pertinent to mention here, that, the course is also approved by DGE&T.

Based on the recommendation of NCVT, with respect to the introduction of IT Literacy courses in ITIs/ITCs, the IT literacy will be mandatory for the session starting from August 2011 and all the trainees undergoing training in ITIs/ITCs under Craftsmen Training Scheme are required to obtain certificate of the IT literacy course, and, that, the NTC shall be issued only after passing the IT Literacy course. DOEACC Society has been approved as one of the assessing and certification body for the purpose. The IT literacy programme of DOEACC viz. BCC is an approved course for the purpose.

In its endeavor to make its quality certification available to the masses, the Society is pleased to announce the conduct of the 1st examination of its Basic Computer Course (BCC) in July 2011.

The first examination of BCC is scheduled to commence during 30-July-2011 and 31-July-2011.

The last date for submission of duly filled in exam forms with fee to DOEACC Society is 30th June, 2011.
